CMF alerts the public about fraudulent e-mail

August 19, 2021 — The Financial Market Commission (CMF) has issued an alert about the circulation of a fraudulent e-mail from the address **abarahonas at cmf dash chile dot cl**, which claims to be from the Commission. This fake e-mail invites people to click on a link to access a supposed new financial information module. Accordingly, the CMF declares to the public that **it has no connection whatsoever with this email address nor with the link the fraudulent message calls to access.**

The Commission also reminds the public about [the special alerts page](#) for investors, policyholders, and banking customers available on its website. Interested parties can verify here whether an entity or person offering financial products or services is supervised by the CMF; review alerts issued by the CMF and other foreign regulators on unregulated entities or activities; and other important advice for the protection of investors, policyholders, and financial clients.
