

CMF to file charges against five applications offering loans for alleged usury

- *They are available on Google Play and other websites.*

July 11, 2025 – The Financial Market Commission (CMF) alerts the public about five applications offering loans that are not supervised by the CMF.

The Commission filed a criminal complaint before the Public Prosecutor's Office against all parties responsible for the following applications, which are available for download from Google Play and other websites:

1. "FINANCIERA CENTA".
2. "SÚPER PRESTA".
3. "MONTICREDI".
4. "CUOTA LIBRE".
5. "LUZ CRÉDITO".

The Commission also reminds the public about the [Fraud Alerts Page](#) for investors, policyholders, and banking customers available on its website. Interested parties can verify here whether an entity or person offering financial products or services is supervised by the CMF; check alerts issued by the CMF and other foreign regulators on unregulated entities or activities; and other important advice for the protection of investors, policyholders, and financial clients.
