

CMF to file charges against 24 applications offering loans for alleged usury

- *They are available for download from Google Play and other websites.*

June 10, 2025 – The Financial Market Commission (CMF) alerts the public about 24 applications that are not supervised by the CMF and offer allegedly usurious loans. The Commission will file a complaint before the Public Prosecutor's Office against any parties responsible for the following applications, which are available for download on Google Play and other websites:
